We invite you to submit an abstract and brief personal biography for a presentation to be given in-person at the conference venue.

The MPD Student Committee will review your abstract and biography, and then conduct a personal interview by phone. Three students will be selected and invited to make a presentation at the conference. The student with the best presentation will win a \$3,000 award and each of the runners up will be awarded \$1,000. The students identified to present will be notified via e-mail in mid-February. Travel arrangements and program details finalized by late March.

Your abstract should be no longer than one page. All abstracts and biographies must be submitted **by the end of January**. Abstracts and the presentation should be tailored to match the conference theme. The topic must be one the student is familiar with and provide interest to an audience of industry leaders with a background in mineral processing.

Should you be chosen to present at the conference, the format for the presentation is MS PowerPoint. Presentations should be less than 20 minutes to be followed with a 5 minute Q&A session.
